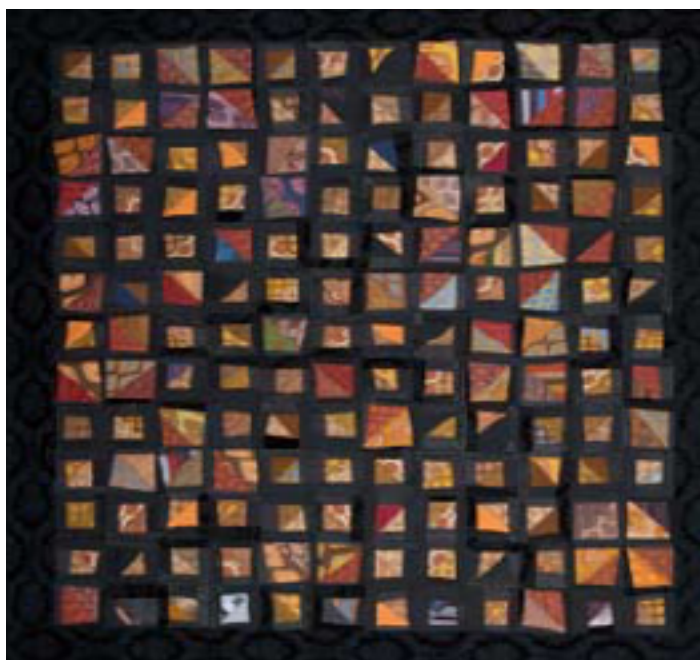




# QUILTING MATTERS

Framed triangles blocks in my quilt were made simply and economically from recycled ties then framed with a variety of black fabrics.

My quilt was made with a combo of silks, velvets, corduroys and cottons. Using mis-matched fabric instead of coordinated, easily-controlled cottons was great fun for a change.

Feel free to make your quilt with any fabric type or mix in your preferred colours in the quilt size that suits you. Also, using your leftover patchwork weight cottons makes a perfect scrap project!

*week 1* working with scraps and how to work with slippery fabrics  
free-style cutting and piecing

*week 2* use the design wall to piece and look at block settings  
discuss machine quilting possibilities

BYO fabric, sewing machine and rotary cutter
