



# QUILTING MATTERS

developing creativity through quiltmaking

## GOOD GIRL BAD GIRL



Join this five-week course as a raw beginner or experienced patchworker. Either way, you will come away with a quilt that's as traditional or contemporary as you desire. We'll make blocks with crooked components and any size seam... *learn how good it is to be bad!*

Over the *first four classes* we look at four traditional blocks and make a very contemporary quilt:

fence rail	log cabin
nine patch	broken dishes

- In the *first half* of each class we wear our **good girl hats** to make blocks properly/perfectly and understand why there are rules in patchwork. We look at cutting, resizing and stitching a perfect  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.
- In the *second half* of each class we don our **bad girl hats** and break all those rules!!
- The *fifth and final class* is a setting class where we look at organising and piecing your unique quilt top.
