Making freehand-cut Drunkard's Path blocks is the starting point of this class.

These blocks make up beautifully in cotton fabrics! Or, if you know the block, try a variation using colourful wool/wool blends, pinwhale corduroy and/or thrift shop men's woollen dressing gowns!!

Make quick 12" blocks... you will love the simplicity of this process and the design-freedom it engenders. Personalise with finishing details/embellishments to make a complete original.

week 1 discuss fabric
 learn the Drunkard's Path block

week 2 use the design board to piece/arrange the blocks
 discuss embellishments: yoyos, stitch, buttons

BYO fabric, sewing machine and rotary cutter
Pattern is included
Rotary mats/rulers are supplied for use in class
Haberdashery, wadding and rotary tools are for sale
