‘USE WHAT’S AT HAND’

With contemporary recipes plus fabric you have on hand, you will make your own Wagga with a modern aesthetic as a by-product of your thrift.

Use fabric at hand or visit thrift shops. Fabrics can be printed, textured, upholstery, patterned or solid colour. Mono-chromatic choices work very well with scraps.

Plan for NO BORDER... simple and quick are the two words that need to be ringing in your head. Complete the look with a back binding to make the rows appear to float off the edge.

morning intro to the Wagga, discuss styles, cutting strips/blocks

afternoon design board to organise rows, learn back binding method

BYO fabric, sewing machine and rotary cutter

Pattern is included

Rotary mats/rulers are supplied for use in class

Haberdashery, wadding and rotary tools are for sale
